

ECO HIKING AT PIPELINE ROAD + GATUN EXPEDITION

Pipeline Road is one of the best ecological trails in Panama and the world, due to the wide variety of reported bird species found there. Additionally, this 17-kilometer trail is an excellent place to admire and enjoy Panamanian biodiversity, which includes plants, butterflies, amphibians, monkeys, and more.

The journey includes access to the observation tower located 32 meters above sea level. The tower features a spiral staircase consisting of 174 steps that will lead you to the observation platform, from which you can view the tree canopy.

The visit continues along one of the trails surrounding the Gamboa Hotel.

After lunch, we will take a tour of Lake Gatún in the Panama Canal.
